

CAMP INFORMATION

Inspiration Point Bible Camp or IPBC, as it is referred to by camp regulars, is our synod's Bible camp, located near Fergus Falls, MN.

We encourage you to send your child to camp where they will have an unforgettable experience growing in the Lord and making new friends. If you are in need of financial assistance in order for your child to attend camp please talk to the Children's Ministry Director.

Transportation Policies:

- As a service to Bethesda families, Children's Ministries will coordinate transportation to and from camp using parent volunteers.
- The responsibility for driving remains with the parents of campers.
- Drivers will be reimbursed the cost of gas and will be provided \$7.00 for lunch. A driving partner will also be provided \$7.00 for lunch.
- Lack of drivers will result in cancellation of church arranged transportation for that particular camp or transportation for a limited number of campers.
- Available space will be filled first come, first served.
- Requests for transportation will be in written form **after** registration and deposit are sent to camp by parents.
- A \$30.00 round trip fee **will accompany the request for transportation** to cover gas, along with \$7.00 for the return trip lunch (please give the 7.00 in cash).
- Transportation request deadline will be May 20th of each year.
- Any requests made after that date will be honored on a space available basis only.

In this packet you will find information regarding camp dates, fees, and church organized transportation. **If your child will be attending camp please send the registration form along with the \$75.00 deposit to camp as soon as possible.
